

How to use Mentimeter



Mentimeter is an online, real time polling tool. It works easily over a smartphone, and we will use it today to gather some input from everyone participating in the meeting. Here's how it works:






Primary Benefits of Regional Destination Recreational Trails



Increased Tourism Spending

Indiana trail users spend on average over \$3,500 per year. +-40% of trail users are visitors, spending 3- 10 times more than locals on lodging, shopping, and dining.



Positive Return on Investment

Case studies of US destination trails indicate that trail construction consistently demonstrates a positive return on the initial investment.



Property Value Benefits

Successful trails are quality of life amenities that prompt increased property values, especially when designed with convenient neighborhood access.



Health and Wellness

Increased accessibility to trails prompt residents to develop active living habits that improve community health, wellness and workforce readiness.




State of IndianaVisionary Trails Map

51.2 Total Facility Miles in Primary Route








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









Portland Arch to I-74














Trail Wayfinding Elements and Roles



Monument Signs

- at major intersections or entry points

 at regular intervals along parallel roadways or where major roadways cross the trail

Directional Signs

 approaching intersections or decision points along the trail

Confirmation Signs

- in areas where there is large gaps between signs or at intersections where no turning movements are required to stay on the trail

- at mile increments along the trail to help users understand location and distance traveled

Kiosks with system map(s)

- at trailheads and major entry points to the trail system

Rules and Regulatory

- at trailheads and major entry points to trail system

Interpretive/Educational

- located as appropriate relative to historic, cultural, or natural sites of significance




Pilot Project Criteria

- Beneficial timing with other development projects










Warren County – The Falls to the Wabash












Warren County - Falls to River Road


